



Million Dollar Renovation Project Begins at Onion Creek Club

AUSTIN, Texas (February 25, 2016) - Onion Creek Club has kicked off 2016 with a \$1 million dollar renovation project beginning with the construction of an All New, expanded State of the Art Fitness Center. The improvements incorporate a completely refreshed dining experience, which includes the new Legends Lounge and Legends Grille with outdoor patio dining. Golf course renovations and improvements are underway, and a new, relocated Pro Shop is part of the project as well.

Construction on the new 3,000 square foot Fitness Center has started, with an estimated opening date of April 15th. The next phase of construction is twofold; the existing kitchen and lounge area will become the new "Legends Lounge" and will be placed where the Fitness Center is currently located, next to the existing Pro Shop with easy access to the outdoor patio! Concurrently, the Membership Office and the storage area behind it, will be converted into the New Pro Shop. This phase is scheduled for completion in early June.

As the Golf Course remains a priority, renovation of the historic, championship golf course continues, including the re-opening of the Original Front 9. Currently, Onion Creek Club has 18 Holes open and ready for play, all on their new Tif-Eagle greens. Clean up from the last flood is ongoing, with the re-grassing of both the #16 green and the Original Front 9 beginning as soon as the soil temperatures hit 60 degrees, on or around June 1st. The Grand Re-Opening of the golf course is scheduled for Labor Day Weekend, although all 27 holes should be open and ready for play by early August 2016! The final phase will be the construction of the New Legends Grille with the Grand Opening scheduled for the 4th of July.

"These renovations will revitalize the Club's functionality and usability," said John Ferguson, General Manager of Onion Creek Club. "We are extremely excited about the future of Onion Creek Club and look forward to seeing these projects come to fruition, and to see our Members, families and Guests enjoy the improvements." "Mother Nature has made things somewhat challenging for the Onion Creek area over the past few years. It is a testament to our Members, staff and the community that we can bounce back, rebuild and refresh and have their crucial support to maintain the vitality of our Club," said Steven Held, President and CEO at the Dominion Golf Group, which owns and operates Onion Creek Club.
